- + bypassing the traditional network service provider/ISP.
- + competing with services offered by the telecom operators, and/or
- + affecting to quality of networks and services



A lot of international Providers


National Providers

Licensing as Telecom Operator

Cross-border services by WTO

- Directly Interconnect to PSTN (Ap-PSTN) -Numbering, QoS,

Free OTT services with large scale

+1M Sub: Cooperate with ISP to improve QoS

+100K sub.: Notification to regulator

- No directly interconnect to PSTN
- Security, Privacy
- User/data Protection

View on principles of regulation

- 1. Different impact levels— different rights and obligations
- 2. User rights to choose affordable services
- 3. Transparency and Publicity: OTTs and ISPs
- 4. No blocking, No throttling legal OTT services
- 5. Non-discriminate specific providers
- 6. Protect and ensure national interests

- Telecoms operators and OTT providers should cooperate to offer affordable rich-feature services to users;
