Subject: Circulation of the Preliminary APT Common Proposals for World Radiocommunication Conference 2015 (WRC-15) and Radiocommunication Assembly 2015 (RA-15) for Endorsement of APT Administrations

I would like to refer to the 5th Meeting of the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity Conference Preparatory Group for WRC-15 (APG15-5) held in Seoul, Republic of Korea from 27 July to 1 August 2015 that the Meeting approved a substantial number of Preliminary APT Common Proposals (PACPs) for the World Radiocommunication Conference 2015 (WRC-15) as well as for the Radiocommunication Assembly 2015 (RA-15). WRC-15 and RA-15 will be held in Geneva, Switzerland from 26 to 30 October 2015, and from 2 to 27 November 2015 respectively. These PACPs are therefore circulated for approval by your Administration in accordance with the established procedure for ACP approval as available in the APT Document Framework.

The PACPs are attached in the file *PACP_Addenda.zip*. These are presented in a number of documents (numbered PACP Addendum-xx) with each document corresponding to a particular WRC-15 Agenda Item (Documents PACP Addendum-01 to 25) or to a proposal to RA-15 (Documents PACP-26). The Endorsement Form is attached in Annex 2 consisting of two Tables; Table 1 contains the PACPs for WRC-15 and Table 2 for RA-15. These two PACP Approval Tables are to be used to indicate your support for the PACPs.

The PACPs are grouped for approval as shown in the Tables. This grouping was established as part of the considerations at the APG15-5. Each particular group constitute a set of proposals that can be considered together for approval. Exact reference to the APG15-5 Output Documents is also given to each PACP Addendum listed on the table.

Your Administration is kindly requested to indicate your support for the PACPs in the last column of each of the PACP Endorsement Tables. <u>Completed Tables should be returned to the APT Secretariat by 18 September 2015</u>. Submission by e-mail (<u>aptapg@apt.int</u>) or by telefax (+6625737479) is preferred. However, in case the administrations require further time for submission of the endorsement due to internal approval processes, please advise the APT Secretariat before the closing date. The period of such extension should not be more than two weeks after the deadline.

PACPs will become APT Common Proposals in accordance with the rules given in the document describing the ACP approval process, which states that a PACP becomes an ACP provided that:

- a) the proposal is *supported by* at least one quarter (25 percent) of all the APT Members; and
- b) the proposal is *not opposed by* more than (50 percent) of the number of Members who support it.

The nature of the approvals by APT Member Administrations of ACPs to WRC-15 will eventually be published by the ITU as part of Document xx in form of a Table in which the support from Administrations will be shown against each of the groups of proposals, the grouping being the same as that shown in the PACP Approval Table.
